HHS/ASPR COVID-19 Outpatient Therapeutics Mini-Series

With its first offering on Wednesday, December 9, 12:00 - 1:00 p.m. EST (offered on additional dates as well), ASPR and Project Echo out of the University of New Mexico School of Medicine will be offering a free mini-series. The series will provide a deep dive on new and emerging COVID-19 outpatient therapeutics, including monoclonal antibodies. The goal of this mini-series is to equip clinicians with the appropriate knowledge, resources, and tools needed to initiate and scale administration of these therapies and reduce strain on the U.S. healthcare system.
