Policy Updates

House Passes Fourth COVID-19 Related Bill

Today, the House is expected to pass a \$484 billion coronavirus aid package. The bill largely funds existing programs created in the CARES Act. The legislation provides \$321 billion for the Paycheck Protection Program, the small business loan program that ran out of money last Thursday. Also included is a \$75 billion fund for health care providers and \$25 billion to ramp up coronavirus testing. This legislation is the fourth coronavirus relief bill in less than two months, which combined total more than \$2.7 trillion in federal funds to combat the disease. The Senate previously passed the legislation on Tuesday and President Trump is expected to sign the bill after House passage. Congress is expected to begin work on a fifth coronavirus related bill in the coming weeks.
