## **Policy Updates**

#### Latest FAQs from the Small Business Administration (SBA) on the Payroll Protection Program

On May 13, 2020, the Small Business Administration (SBA) issued <u>FAQ No. 47</u> which extended the safe harbor repayment date provided to certain recipients of Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loans. This repayment date, which was previously extended from May 7, 2020 to May 14, 2020, has again been extended to May 18, 2020. Pursuant to the SBA's FAQ 47 issued late in the day on May 13, any borrower that applied for a PPP loan and repays the loan in full by May 18, 2020, will be deemed by the SBA to have made the required certification concerning the necessity of the loan request in good faith. Borrowers do not need to apply for this extension.
