# NHPCO to Meet with CMS Regarding Hospice Audit System Challenges

NHPCO has a meeting scheduled in January with leaders from the Center for Program Integrity (CPI) at the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to discuss challenges with the system of hospice audits, including how poorly structured and targeted audits can disrupt hospice operations and harm patient access to care. The meeting will include NHPCO leadership and representatives from member hospices. Discussion will be informed by both a recent survey of hospices and conversations with NHPCO members. #### CMS Requests Information on the VBID Model

In December, CMS released a <u>request for information</u> (RFI) on the Value-Based Insurance Design (VBID) Model to help inform potential future Model policy development. This RFI seeks information on various aspects of the VBID model, particularly hospice care, including hospice access and network adequacy considerations. This RFI also includes questions regarding health equity, including flexibilities that would enable Medicare Advantage Organizations to target VBID benefits based on certain factors. Comments are due to the VBID Mailbox at <u>VBID@cms.hhs.gov</u> by January 31, 2024.

NHPCO will submit a response to the RFI and is soliciting member feedback through <u>a Qualtrics survey</u>. To ensure your comments inform the final response, please complete the survey by Wednesday, January 26. Any questions can be directed to <u>innovation@nhpco.org</u>.

Measures of Excellence (MOE): New Dashboard and Fourth Quarter Data Submission

**MOE Dashboard Update:** For members who submit MOE data, a new page is now available on your Dashboard. Rates – Falls, Medication Errors, and Infections provides patient safety data by overall rate, as well as incident rates per 1,000 patient days. Members are encouraged to download the recently revised Measures of Excellence User Guide for more information.

Fourth Quarter Data Submission Deadline: MOE data for the fourth quarter (Oct. - Dec. 2023) is due on January 28, 2024. Please reach out to moe@nhpco.org with any questions.

**Quality Connections Credit:** Quality Connections participants who submitted four quarters of MOE data in 2023 may now login to the Quality Connections portal and complete the attestation to receive a second MOE credit in the Measurement pillar. **About MOE:** The Measures of Excellence (MOE) is a quarterly data collection tool and dashboard that organizations may use to track operational and clinical data to inform high-quality care. The quarterly MOE Dashboard allows organizations to compare themselves to others for benchmarking and the MOE National Report provides data that supports a comprehensive review of national participant performance. The MOE Dashboard and National Report are exclusive NHPCO member benefits.

#### Evaluation of Grief Support Services (EGGS) Data Submission Deadline

**Data Submission Deadline:** Data submission for the second half of 2023 is due by January 28, 2024, for the period July 1 through December 31, 2023. Surveys must be submitted by January 28 in order to be included in 2023 data.
